

Conway-Perry Baptist Association Camp Rules

Camp Program

1. All campers will follow the schedule as outlined by the Director
2. All campers will attend all events as scheduled by the Director
3. All campers will be expected to participate in all Camp activities

Housekeeping

1. Camp facilities and grounds will be kept clean and left clean
2. Personal belongings will be kept neat and orderly

Attire

1. All campers will be expected to dress modestly, as a Christian
2. No sleeveless shirts will be allowed
3. Shorts that are shorter than fingertip length will not be allowed
4. Showing of undergarments or excess skin will not be allowed
5. Two-piece bathing suits will not be allowed and appropriate covering will be worn to and from the swimming area
6. No clothing with inappropriate messages or statements
7. Shoes will be worn except when showering, swimming or sleeping

Conduct

1. Everyone will be expected to conduct themselves in a manner pleasing unto God
2. Alcohol and tobacco products along with any substance deemed to possibly be detrimental to facilities will not be allowed
3. Cell phones and other electronics are not allowed. Guardians should communicate with Campers through their Church's sponsor and then only in the case of an emergency.
4. Full cooperation and compliance is expected from each Camper

Grounds

1. No one will leave the Camp grounds without the permission of the Director
2. Girls/Boys cabin areas are off-limits to members of the opposite gender

Medication

Each Church, not the Association, will be responsible for the distribution of necessary medication to their Campers. Guardians should communicate all medical needs with their Church sponsors.

Background Checks

Each Church is responsible for providing the Association with a current Criminal Background Check for each attending sponsor. No one will be allowed on the Camp facility without prior submission of this form.
